Colorado Eagles assistant coach and Drayton Valley native Greg Pankewicz will never live down his actions last Saturday night.

Pankewicz, infuriated by the linesman's actions, jumped down from the bench and started screaming face-to-face with Wilson.

But screaming wasn't enough for the former NHLer, who played 21 games with the Ottawa Senators and Calgary Flames. He hopped back on the bench and began stripping off pieces of clothing -including his shoes -and tossing them onto the ice in a rage.

Pankewicz left the bench wearing only pants and socks and still barking at Wilson.
